

IMPACTED BY HURRICANE

IRMA? YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR STATE AND FEDERAL BENEFITS



Already have Food Stamps (SNAP/EBT)? If food you bought spoiled or was lost because of Hurricane Irma, you can request replacement benefits no later than 10 days after the loss of food. SNAP benefits can be used for hot meals through Sept. 30, 2017. Disaster Food Stamps have not been announced as of Sept. 14, but may be in the coming days.



If Irma made your primary home unavailable or you have incurred disaster related expenses not otherwise covered, you may be eligible for FEMA benefits. FEMA awards benefits on a household basis, make sure only one person applies per address. Apply online or by calling 1-800-621-3362 by Nov. 9



Did you lose your job, or was your work or self-employment interrupted because of the hurricane? If so, you may be eligible for Disaster Unemployment Assistance. Apply by Oct. 16, 2017 online or by calling 1-800-385-3920.
